1. HTML files that are live are files that have been put to your remote site, and are viewable online.		
2. Local files are saved on your computer, or a flash drive. Most of the time you work on local files.		
3. Centering your site in browser is a two step css rule process		
4. The first step of centering site is to apply the following rule: body: Block: Text align: center		
5. The second step of centering site is to apply the following rule: container div: block: text align: left		
6. You can use Photoshop to produce jpg, gifs, and png		
7. A 24 bit PNG file has transparent areas, and has photographic areas		
8. Gifs are better than png or or jpps for photos		
9. In Photoshop's "Save for Web" rather than "Save" you are provided the simplest compression options		
10. Gifs are best for flat logos (non photographic art)

14. If you change a rule, you only need to upload the CSS file to make changes across all your pages		
15. A "global change" means a change across your whole site. Example, changing the background property of a div		
16. Global changes are efficient because you reduce the time it takes to makes the change		
17. Global changes are not efficient because you the changes only affect some pages		
18. Web Design encompasses: graphic design, color theory, business objectives, is technical		
19. Smart Phones have not had much of an impact on Web Design		
20. Images can be attached to backgrounds of CSS rules as well as included in a paragraph		
Your remote files are all current, but your local drive just died, and so you are re-setting up on a new computer		
21. You would first start by doing a new site/ entering your login info		
22. You will have local selected, and click put - that will get your files from the remote server.		
23. You will have local selected, and click get - that will get your files from the remote server.		
24. It doesn't matter if you interchange the get/put command or if you have local/remote selected
